#### Choose Bullet and Introducer sizes to suit surgical site

Bullet diameter	Outside diameter of Introducer	Minimum reamed diameter	End-to-end length	Order code
7mm	9mm (black handle)	IOmm	640mm	660-001
9mm	llmm (silver handle)	l2mm	480mm	

#### Prepare STIMULAN Rapid Cure 20cc

Use the mixing solution from the tube provided in the pack. Do not add any other fluid. Replace the bead mat with the Bullet Mat.



Allow paste to set undisturbed for at least 8 minutes after mixing. Flex Bullet Mat to release bullets


#### Technique for pre-loading and using the Introducer




Ensure retaining tab at the distal tip is as shown



Insert Introducer slowly into surgical site



Remove obturator and insert bullets to level required to fill void



Insert obturator and apply positive pressure. Maintain positive pressure and pull the Introducer back, leaving **STIMULAN** bullets inside the void
